We look forward to seeing you throughout the season - this really is a stunning show that you do not want to miss!

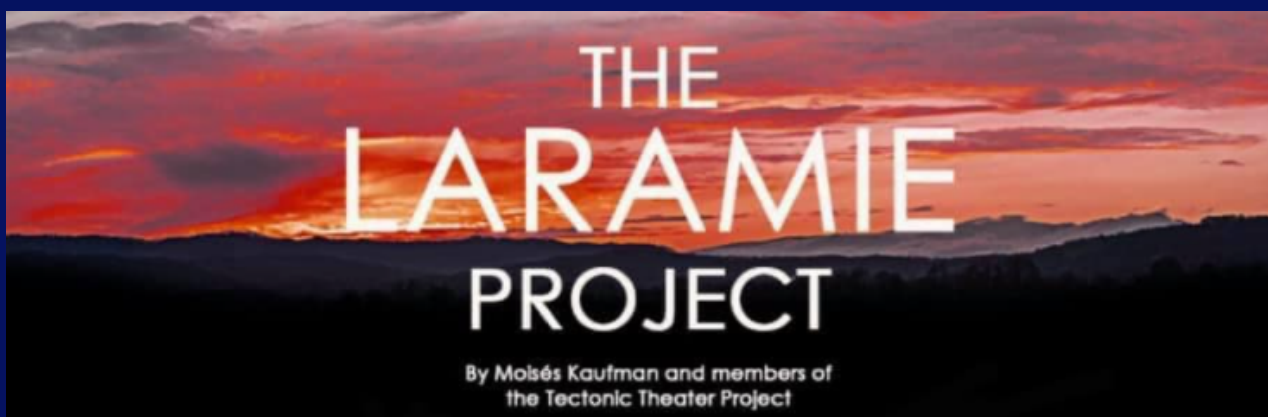

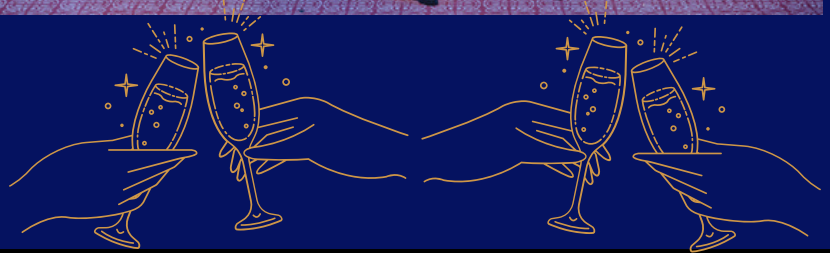

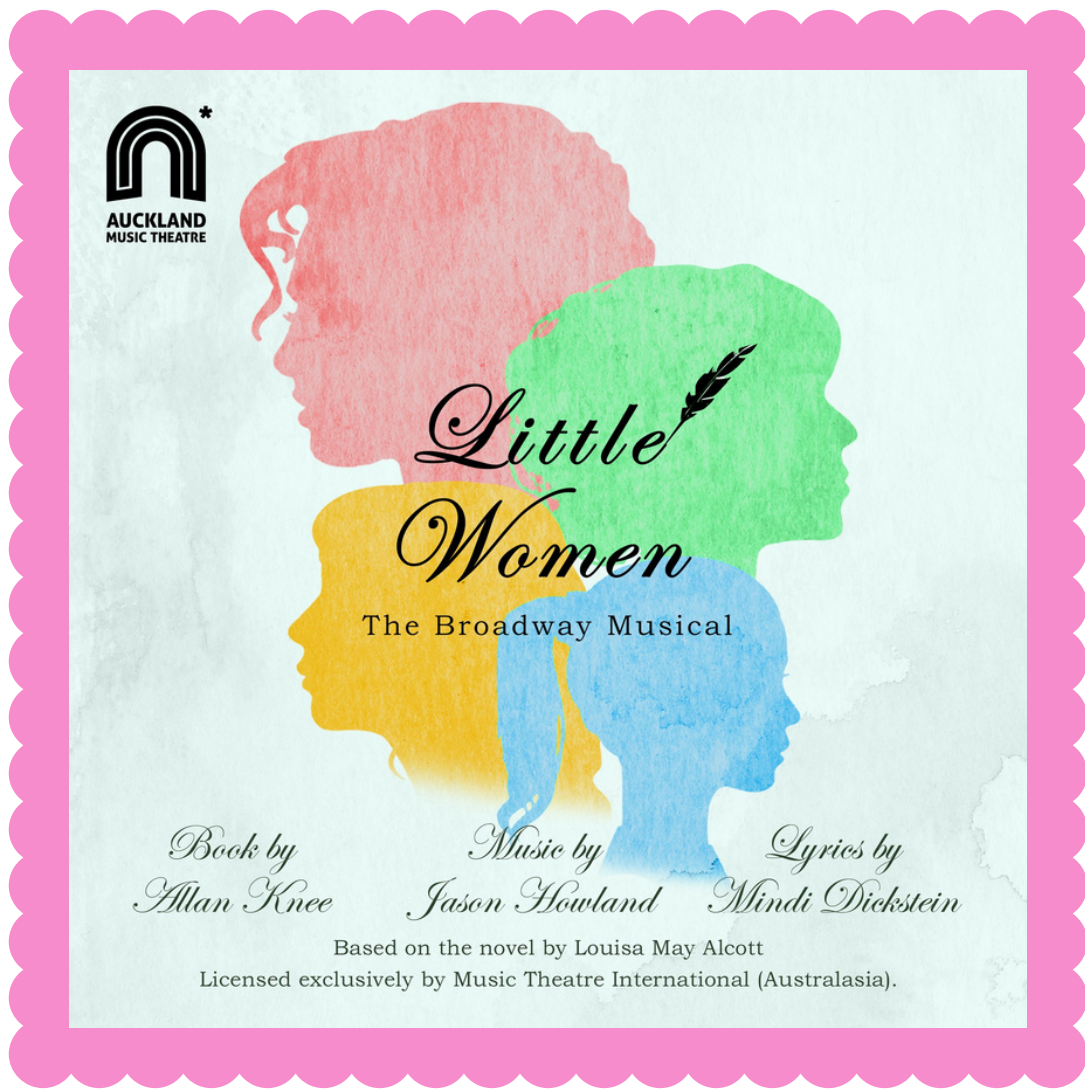
